20-year Air Force veteran was shot down September 25, 1970 and released January 1, 1971 as the war was winding down and troops were preparing to withdraw. He and Fred Black, who was in the same aircraft, are the longest last prisoners of war. Because of their exposure received the Air Force Cross which marks rest below the Medal of Honor.

Robinson credits four things with keeping him going during those dark days in North Vietnam. "There is impact both in each other, both in my country and both in my Heavenly Father to see us through."

Robinson played an important part in his survival. His experiences reminded him of the difficulties of Bible characters
