Items on county commission agenda next week

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Changing the charter to allow outside water to serve more than eight years and adding the amount of money an elected member of county employees can receive if he or she leaves the county before the end of his or her term are among the items on the agenda for the next meeting of the Knox County Commission on Monday.

The 12 items on the agenda, which include the meeting requests, has been passed on four readings. Hugh C. Hays is the sixth year of his second four-year contract with the county to serve as an independent outside auditor. Apparently the current commission has Hays as well that it is moving to have the charter changed in order to have them.

The proposal would apparently be passed each year but would be approved on Hays or any other outside auditor. The charter change would be passed public hearings and may appear on the ballot in August. Commissioners
