George Paidousis chief of security for Knox County Schools: "We do not get involved in school discipline." Paidousis made these remarks in a speech Monday evening, March 12 at a Town Hall East meeting.

Paidousis was appointed chief of security in 2013 by then superintendent Dr. Jim McIntyre after 30 years with the Kingwille Police Department (KPD). Paidousis described the difference between school
