

Bud Armstrong Halts Raid on County Treasury

Law Director, Five Commissioners Defend Charter and Protect Taxpayers

 The Knox County Board of Commissioners on Tuesday halted a proposed raid on the county treasury by the state's attorney general, after a meeting with the law director and five commissioners.

The state's attorney general, Eric Schmitt, had proposed a raid on the county treasury to pay for the state's share of the cost of the state's new judicial system. The county's law director, Bud Armstrong, and five commissioners defended the county's charter and the protection of taxpayers.

Armstrong said that the county's charter is a contract between the county and its taxpayers. He said that the county has a duty to protect the interests of its taxpayers and that the proposed raid would violate that duty.

The commissioners agreed with Armstrong and voted to reject the proposed raid. They also voted to ask the state's attorney general to withdraw the proposal.
