Project Grad, sidewalk study on Work Session agenda

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When the Knox County Commission meets today at 5 p.m. in Work Session the members face an agenda of over 50 items. Among those numerous items is a resolution to approve a partnership continuation memorandum between Knox County Schools and Project G2AD.

That program, as well as magnet schools, was slated for cutbacks until Knox County Mayor Tim Burchett promised to split \$1.5 million in funding with the school system. That promise is separate from the mayor's budget proposal.

Commission Chairman Randy Smith and other commissioners may select items from the large agenda for public discussion. Most work session items will go on to the body's regular meeting next Monday.
