The Knoxville City Council is being asked by the Community Development Department to authorize \$135,955 for Volunteer Ministry Center to hire two community outreach workers. The idea is to have these Ministry Center employees to work with “unsheltered persons experiencing homelessness” primarily around the intersection of Broadway and Magnolia Avenue.

The spot on Broadway has long been a gathering place for homeless, just across the street from the Volunteer Ministry Center, and some of the homeless
