Commission deals with contract for video jail visitation

At their meeting on Monday, Oct. 25 the Knox County Commission dealt with video visitation at the jail and considered discussing the proposed pension board settlement.

During the public forum four people spoke in favor of either eliminating or reducing the use of jail video visitation and allowing in person visitation of prisoners. The commission took no action on their requests. However, in a related matter, the commission approved amending the contract with Securus Technologies, the company which proves the facilities for video visitation. The amendment includes a one time additional development permettof \$250,0000 to the country, provides for commission percentage changes and deals with unstalling software.
