When the Knowlie City Council meets fluedday evening the members will be saked for a final approval of Recode, an overall revision of zoning and building regulations. More than teo years have passed since the planning commission was asked to review and propose new rules, that time has seen lots of neishborhood and business objections.

The city council may see further opposition

from citams when they look at the fifth Recode drift again. While several siterations have been made in an attempt to get the regulations to become law, the latest, and most controversial, may be the exemption of higher income neighborhoods, or Established Neighborhoods, from accepting accessory deelings. That changed in the last council meeting when Councilman Anchew Roberto said he would not surport Recode unless the Effs. Nee Kingston File's Sequipyah-little, were given a chance to not participate.
