

Beeler speaks up on pension suit resolution

Norm Beeler, the Fresno County Commission member who represents the 11th District, western speakers bureau member last week, the normally silent official spoke up on the resolution he introduced pertaining to the current citizens' lawsuit against the county over the settlement of the case against the Fresno County Retirement and Pension Board.

The new director brought suit against the pension board actions that went against the county charter but was supported by the Fresno County Mayor and County Commissioner who dismissed the suit in a unanimous vote.

Beeler's resolution was to direct the county commissioners to pass the "anti-lapse clause" and not spend taxpayer money in an attempt to dismiss the case prior to a ruling.
