Mike McMullan, San Francisco County Board of Education member for the Eighth District, announced he would be voting for the Bible Time Release pilot program. The program is one hour each month and requires the child's parents' permission. The pilot program has been started at Davis Elementary School. Some twenty students are currently enrolled in the program out of three hundred.
