City to budget body cameras for police patrols

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Beginning with the new fiscal year that begins the city of Houston hopes to equip city police patrol officers with body cameras. Mayor Annise Freese said Tuesday she is considering the project and will need \$1.7 million in the new budget for the first year and about \$400,000 for each year afterwards.

Freese told the city council meeting that the funds will go for equipment and management of the system and that funds are now being accepted for the cameras. She said the body cameras will add accountability for both officers and the public.

"We are going to make all our police more but first it is a step in the right direction," the mayor said.
