Beginning with the new fiscal year this July the City of Knoxille hopes to equip city police patrol officers with body cameras. Mayor ladys kincarnon said fueeday she is committed to the project and will seek \$1.7 million in the new budget for the first year and sout \$600,000 for each year afterwards.
