Order of Knox County Health Department Allowing Knox County Businesses to Reopen While Encouraging Continued Adherence to Health Guidelines to Limit The Spread Of COVID-19

Pursuant to Executive Order 30 of the Governor of the State of Tennessee dated April 28, 2000, which vests the Kinox County Health Diversion, under Section 1(c), with the authority to sus additional orders or measures related to the containment or amangement of the spread of the CDVID-19, which permits the Kinox County Health Diversion to issue more or less stringent guidelines than those of the governor, regarding the opening, dosure, or generation of businesses, cognizations, or womes in Kinox County including those listed in Paragraph 11 of said order No. 30, including but not limited to those referred to as "Nucleoses or exercisations that enform close- contain benominal seriors."

- Let it therefore be ordered by the Knox County Health Director, that Knox County adopts the orders of the State of Tennass and the governor's guidance and recommendations under Executive Orders 30 and 31 regarding the following:

 - Individuals.
 - Employers,
 - Social gatherings of more than 10 individuals,
 - Staying at home recommendations,
 - Persons are urged to wear face covering in public places,
 Nursing homes and similar facilities closed to visitors,
 - Special care should be taken to protect vulnerable populations
 - Each business should follow the Community Strategy for Reopening
 - Persons with COVID-19 or COVID-19 symptoms must stay at home
 Employers shall not require or allow employees with COVID-19 to report to work
